Equipment List

Day Pack

Please pack these items separately in a small day pack for **day one (Tuesday)**. This pack will be carried on the ferry with students and eliminates any delays caused by luggage transfer logistics on the island.

- Swim suit and beach towel
- Sun shirt/rashie
- Wide brimmed hat
- Sunscreen
- Filled water bottle (minimum of 600ml)
- Small snack or some change to buy food on the MICAT ferry

The following should be used as a guide for the basic equipment necessary for this camp (main luggage must not exceed 15kg and will not be accessible until check-in):

- Sufficient clothing for the duration of the stay, including at least 2 bath towels
- Swimmers and beach towel
- Wet weather gear (cheap poncho is recommended)
- Enclosed showering shoes
- Toiletries including soap, toothpaste, comb, sunscreen and insect repellent
- Hat
- Sandshoes or joggers for walking (not new ones)
- Sleeping bag or blankets, sheet and pillow
- Torch
- Water bottle (for trips)
- Plate, dessert bowl, cup, cutlery (knife/fork/spoon) and tea towel
- Fishing rod, skim boards and snorkel gear (optional)
- Fancy dress for bonfire night

Do not bring

- Valuable items – we cannot accept responsibility and do not have secure storage
- As the area is solar powered, do not bring hair dryers, hair straighteners, ipods, iphones/phones or electrical items.
