ANZAC Day March - Sunday 25 April 8:30am - 10:30am (approximate)

- The ANZAC Day March is from Stockland Caloundra to the Caloundra RSL Memorial Garden
- Students, Parents and Staff are invited to represent CalCC in the ANZAC Day March. Please assemble at the CalCC banner in the carpark between Kmart and MyCar (previously Kmart Tyre & Auto).
- Students must wear their full, correct formal uniform, including College hat or College secondary cap and should consider bringing a water bottle.
- Follow the directions of the Marshalls and CalCC Staff as to the position of our College in the procession.
- Student representatives of the College will lay a wreath at the Memorial Garden on behalf of the CalCC community after the march.
- Due to limited space in the Memorial Garden, a large video screen will be set up in the RSL carpark.
- Parents/carers who are not marching must be at the RSL carpark immediately after the march to collect their children.
- As the ANZAC Day March occurs on Sunday this year, we understand that some students may not be able to attend due to church commitments.

COVID-19 Guidelines

- Use hand sanitiser.
- Bring your own water bottle and don't share it with others.
- Adults need to remain 1.5m from other adults and if this is not possible, please wear a mask.

- Schools are not officially participating in the Dawn Service this year, however, students may attend with their families if they wish.
- Students attending this event are not required to wear their College uniform.
- Seating will be limited to veterans and their immediate family members only.
