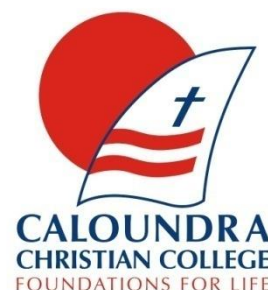

Re: Year 12 End of Year Events

This letter is to confirm details for the Graduation Ceremony and Formal, as well as providing a schedule of the activities surrounding it. An official Formal Invitation will be distributed in Week 1, Term 4.

Secondary Presentation Evening - 6:30pm - 8:30pm, Monday 15 November 2021

Our Secondary presentation evening marks the beginning of our end of year celebrations. More specific information about this evening will be communicated early in Term 4.

Year 12 Chapel, Graduation Rehearsal – 8:30-11:00am, Wednesday 17 November 2021

All Year 12 students will be required to participate in the running of their final Junction (Chapel service) on Wednesday 17 November and run through the details of the Graduation Ceremony and Formal. We will also take this opportunity to complete the Student Exit Survey followed by morning tea.

Graduation Ceremony – 4:00pm, Thursday 18 November 2021

- **4:00pm** - Graduates assemble in the Gregson & Weight car park at the bottom of the College driveway
- **4:15pm** - Graduates arrive at Ceremony and walk the red carpet (as per College protocol, only Year 12 graduates are permitted to walk the red carpet)
- **4:30pm** - Graduation Ceremony in Caloundra CityLife Baptist Church auditorium. Guests and Graduates will be served canapes and drinks by our CalCC Hospitality students as graduates arrive
- **5:15pm** - Opportunity for photos
- **6:00pm** - Graduates depart on the College bus to arrive at The Lakehouse by 6:30pm

This ceremony is an opportunity to celebrate each graduating student and the class as a whole.

Graduation photos are being taken by a College representative. Images will be available through the College with details to follow. There will be an opportunity to have photographs taken until the graduates depart for the Formal dinner.

Formal Dinner – 6:30pm, Thursday 18 November 2021

The College will be hosting the 2021 Year 12 Formal at The Lakehouse, Mountain Creek. This part of the evening will occur directly after the Graduation Ceremony. Please arrive by 6:30pm to welcome Graduates.

The cost for the evening is \$110.00 per head for the Year 12 Graduates and guests. Please be aware that this is an **ALCOHOL FREE event** consistent with all College functions. Graduates will be given **three** invitations to distribute to their guests. The evening has a formal structure with arranged seating for students, parents and guests. For the consideration of all guests and graduates, any siblings attending will be required to sit with their parents, and will be considered an adult for catering and costing purposes. There are no discounted meal tickets or alternative meal arrangements for younger guests.
